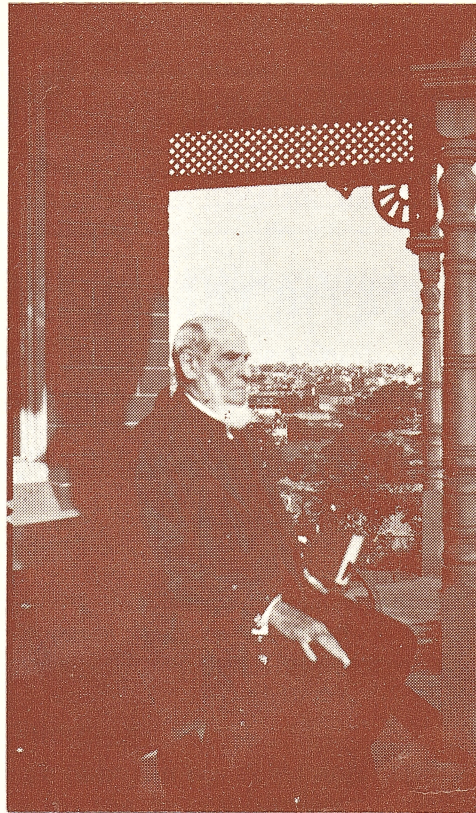
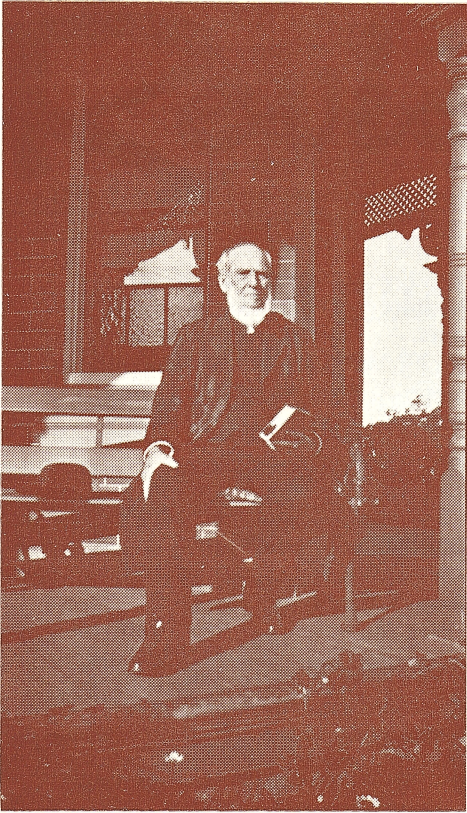


SEPTIMUS HUNGERFORD
